GLOSSARY OF TERMS	
EDI	EDI is short for Electronic Data Interchange. EDI provides a means to exchange information electronically.
EFT	EFT is short for Electronic Funds Transfer. EFT provides for the electronic payment and collection of money.
EFW	EFW is short for Electronic Funds Withdrawal. SC DOR utilizes this term as it is the same term the IRS uses. EFW is just another name for Bank Draft or ACH Debit.
ACH CREDIT	ACH Credit is where the taxpayer pushes the money out of their bank account into the State's account. This is done by a bank online bill pay similar to what you may use to pay utilty bills, etc.
ACH DEBIT	See EFW.
FEDSTATE ELF	The taxpayer's return is filed by a preparer using a third party software package (H & R Block, Liberty, Jackson Hewitt, etc).
FEDSTATE ONLINE	Taxpayer utilizes an online tax preparation and efiling software to file their individual income tax return. The most popular programs are TurboTax by Intuit, TaxCut by H & R Block and TaxSlayer.
THIRD PARTY SOFTWARE	Third party software is any filing/payment product developed by an outside company in cooperation with SC DOR resulting in the indirect filing of payments/returns with South Carolina. SC DOR considers all individual income tax software products to be third party as well as all sales tax filing products outside of ESales to be third party.
RAL	RAL is short for Refund Anticipation Loans. They are high interest loans that allow the taxpayer to get their federal refund back in about two days or less, but at a high cost. Fees for the RAL are typically removed from the federal refund amount, but could be removed from the state refund. The taxpayer does NOT get the state refund any quicker by going the RAL route.
DIRECT DEPOSIT	The placement of an individual income tax return refund from South Carolina directly in the bank account of a taxpayer/spouse.
RTN	Short for Routing Transit Number. The RTN is the first set of numbers between the funky symbols on the bottom of your personal check. RTNs on deposit slips are not honored by the ACH network.
BAN	Short for Bank Account Number. Typically, the second set of numbers between the funky symbols at the bottom of a personal check. Business checks can have BANs first and RTNs second.

NOTE: ONLY THE RETURN TYPES AND FORMS LISTED CAN BE FILED EITHER BY ELECTRONIC OR 2D BARCODE FILING METHODS.
